**Volunteer Safety Monitors and Ushers Needed!** In order to resume worshiping in person, we need teams of five volunteers to serve as Safety Monitors and Ushers: one person assists the line outside, keeps the reservation roster to make sure folks are pre-booked, enforces six feet of social distancing, advises attendees of the procedure at doorway, and reminds people that masks are required at all times; two people conduct wellness survey, temperature check, mask check, and contact tracing log entries; and two people to lead people to their designated seats.
