A reminder from Presbytery as we wish Rev. Clémot farewell on her last day at LAC, November 15<sup>th</sup>: When a pastor resigns from a pastorate, retires from service, or becomes Pastor Emerita, that minister shall no longer perform pastoral functions such as weddings, baptisms, funerals, hospital visitation or counseling. Active or inactive church members should not request a former pastor to perform pastoral duties. If requested, the pastor shall tactfully decline. On occasion, the pastor or moderator may, with the approval of session/council, invite the former pastor to perform such duties."
