Music Notes: Brahms composed his first cello sonata between 1862 and 1865. The opening theme of the first movement is a homage to Bach, taken from that composers Art of the Fugue. When Brahms offered it to his publisher, he described it as "a violoncello sonata which, as far as both instruments are concerned, is certainly not difficult to play," a statement which you can ask Virginia to verify after today's postlude.

This is a substantial work for the cello, which is the polite way of saying that the postlude may be a bit longer than usual today; it is, however, well worth the time invested in its listening.

In the course of many revisions, the original eucharistic emphasis of this text has shifted to a hymn of thanksgiving for a wide range of human experience, with a Christological summation. It is set here to the tune that is customary in North America, though not elsewhere.

CREATION AND PROVIDENCE



Guitar chords do not correspond with keyboard harmony.

Though a lack of punctuation makes this text appear freeform and the flowing tune enhances a sense of movement, each stanza here is firmly anchored by a final weighty word (praise, save, thanks, life, peace, home), a sign of God's eternal presence in an ever-changing world.
