


GOD'S COVENANT WITH ISRAEL

#### Welcome to Worship

#### Today's bulletin cover features "Moses" from Elena Kotliarker's Patriarch's of Faith series.

Sometimes children have to sit through church longer than their little bodies can handle, so we created **Worship Wiggle Bags**! These bags can be found in the back of the sanctuary and they contain activities that help our youngest disciples engage and participate in the service, and most importantly, they help teach our kids that "big church" is for them, too. After using a Worship Wiggle Bag, please put everything back inside the bag and return it, so we can make sure we have plenty of bags stocked and ready for next week's worship wiggles!

**Music Notes:** The funny-looking notes in this week's closing hymn come from an early American tradition of notation meant to assist people to read music. The shape of the note indicates its pitch relative to the scale the tune is based on, so there is no need to memorize different key signatures or even the names of the notes on the staff. Even better, there were only four shapes for four syllables, not seven: Fa, So, La, and Si. Fa, So, and La repeat in the scale, and Si is the leading tone. That might sound complicated, but it essentially allows you to sing a melody in any key with the knowledge of just four note shapes. Brilliant! And don't worry, you can still read it the way you are used to today, with the interesting shapes added for your enjoyment. Want to learn more? Look up "Sacred Harp" and "Fasola singing."
